In the 1960's, a diocesan mission from Ireland, including Mercy Sisters, arrived in Peru to serve the newly populated area in Alto Trujillo. Meanwhile, another group of Mercy Sisters was arriving in Boca Raton, Florida, to open a Catholic School at St. Joan of Arc parish. Within that group, Sister Inmaculata.

In the 90s, Sister Inmaculata was appointed Mother General. She spent six years visiting all the Mercy communities in Asia, Africa, and South America. At the end of her term, Sister Inmaculata is free to choose her next place, and yes, she chose to live and work in Alto Trujillo, Peru! After three months of intensive Spanish, she settles into a new life, focusing on the children, their protection, nourishment, and education.

Sister Inmaculata was the one bringing the generous hearts from Boca Raton to Alto Trujillo, but it was the community itself that envisioned the projects.
